

TEXAS XXI HISTORY

In October 2000 four members of the Blue Knights TX 1 Motorcycle Club, saw the potential of starting a Blue Knights chapter south of the Ft. Worth - Dallas metroplex area and met in Italy, Texas to form the TX XXI Chapter. By the end of December, 19 officers had applied for membership.

Blue Knights TX XXI chartered as a club in the Rio Grande Conference with the Blue Knights International of Bangor, Maine in January 2001 and the growth has yet to slow down. By December 31, 2001, about one year after starting, TX XXI had grown to 57 members. Now in 2008, we are the largest club in the Rio Grande Conference with over 120 members!

We have had supporters and club members help design and finance one of the best looking logos of any motorcycle club (top left of this page). We now have a full line of clothing with our logo on hats, t-shirts, knit shirts, do-rags, etc. We have paid everyone back for all of our start up fees, and our club is now debt free.

We have seen many of the Ladies of the Knights go from passengers to riders and are now riding along side their partners. Our Chaplain became an ordained minister and tries to keep us on the right path. If you and your bike get off the right path and you fall down then we have Boo Boo Bear to make you feel better and to remind all of us to be careful.

Our club doesn't sit still much and we aren't real big on meetings. Our meetings are once a month on the second Thursday. We move the meeting locations around to try to make it more convenient for our members to attend due to the fact that our membership is spread out over 4 counties.
